Job Profile Overview:

As a labourer working as a Pneumatic Driller you will be required to operate a drill required to bore small diameter holes into rock.

Working Conditions:

- Extended/long shift hours in changing weather conditions
- Construction jobs require workers to be in good physical condition
- Noisy and dusty environments on dynamic terrains
- Busy job environment with multiple trades working together
- Elevated work platforms and cramped spaces frequently alternating between standing, kneeling, and lifting
- Personal Protective Equipment will be required (e.g., steel-toed safety boots, safety glasses/goggles, etc.)
- A Respiratory Protection Mask is required to be worn while performing work

Experience, qualifications, and certifications that are considered an asset:

- Must have experience as an air track pneumatic operator with conventional anchor drilling and injection bore anchor (IBO) drilling
- Has experience as a Shotcrete Nozzleman
- Has experience performing and assisting with anchor tensioning and testing on site including and not limited to proof testing, lift-off testing, and performance testing.
- Has experience assisting with Welded Wired Mesh (WWM) installation
- Has experience assisting on general maintenance of the construction site
- Ability to lift up-to 50 lb weight
- An ACI nozzleman certification and Ground Disturbance level 2 certificate considered an asset
- Respirable crystalline silica training considered an asset
- Valid Red Seal, Journey Person or Apprenticeship Construction Craft Worker certification considered an asset
- Experience working in heavy civil construction or road building considered an asset
- Must have good communication, interpersonal & coordination skills
- Fall Protection, Ariel Work Platform, Confined Space Entry considered an asset
- Have an understanding and the ability to follow safe work procedures.
